

STRENGTHENING WASH IN FOOD FOR PEACE ACTIVITIES

PRO-WASH (Practices, Research and Operations in Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) is a five-year project led by Save the Children and funded by the USAID Office of Food for Peace (FFP). PRO-WASH works with partners to strengthen the quality, effectiveness and sustainability of WASH practices in FFP-funded development and emergency food security activities.

PRO-WASH is building a platform of WASH capacity-strengthening activities and engaging in applied research initiatives to identify field-viable solutions for improving WASH service delivery for chronically vulnerable and food insecure populations.

WHAT WE DO:

- Consult widely with the WASH community of practice
- Collect and analyze evidence; identify effective practices
- Strengthen skills and capacities among FFP implementing partners
- Facilitate learning opportunities and linkages across FFP implementers to share best practices and connect to with innovations and research in WASH to address challenges in the field
- Develop and facilitate in-country and regional capacity-building and knowledge sharing events
- Update and create new tools, guides, and technical guidance; share and disseminate knowledge
- Link to other WASH actors, and supports applied research into field-viable solutions for improving WASH service delivery
- Provide remote, one-on-one technical support in key WASH topic areas
