LACK OF ACCESS TO EDUCATION

Whether it's due to global displacement or ongoing poverty, millions of parents can't send their children to school to continue learning. Right now, **12 million refugee children** have no access to education and **2 in 5 children** living in poverty in the U.S. have no access to preschool.

VIOLENT CONFLICT

Global conflicts are an immediate danger for families, businesses and entire economies. Worldwide, **1 in every 5 children** lives in a conflict zone, where families often lose members and need to move from their homes into displacement camps where they struggle to provide the basic necessities their kids need to survive.



HUNGER CRISIS

For children living in countries affected by conflict, natural disaster and poverty, hunger poses a deadly threat. **1 in 5 deaths** among children under the age of 5 are due to severe malnutrition, while **783 million people** don't know where their next meal will come from. Hunger knows no borders, no boundaries and no limits, and it strips children of a healthy childhood.
